BRACER / ARM GUARD

Bracer, Vambrace, Armguard, call it what you will, lets make armour!

This workshop is presented especially for St Ives Medieval Faire.

In this 4 hour class, you will learn how to cut from a pattern, bevel edges, emboss, dye, and assemble this quirky bracer which can give you the skills you need to create similar pieces or more of the same!

We will use 2.5mm natural veg tanned cowhide, to give the look of heavy duty armour, without the weight. Once assembled you can add your hardware.



For the novices, we will practice carving and tooling this simple design on scrap leather before attempting your masterpiece.

Burnishing edges will finish off your professional look, including setting your hardware. Loads of fun!

A gauntlet is armour that also embraces the hand, so don't be confused!
